Facility Information

- Reinforced steel 9-story building (Completed in July 1997)
- Maximum capacity 350 guests
- Number of guestrooms: 85
- 9th floor bath with a fine view



Room type

- Ocean side Japanese-style rooms (12.5 tatami mat room + 4.5 tatami mat room) capacity 6 guests, 32 rooms (20.7 m² + 7.4 m²)
- Ocean side Japanese-style rooms (10 tatami mat room + 4.5 tatami mat room) capacity 5 guests, 30 rooms (16.5 m² + 7.4 m²)
- Ocean side Deluxe Suite (19 tatami mat room + Western room with two beds), 1 room
- Mountain side Twin room, 6 rooms (21 m²)
- Mountain side Single room, 16 rooms (14.5 m²)
